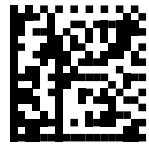

Dear Sir/Madam,

N. C. Gen. Stat. § 143-553 provides that all persons employed by an employing unit who owe money to the State of North Carolina and whose salaries are paid in whole or in part by State funds must make full restitution of the amount owed as a condition of the continued employment. This statute also requires the employer to provide written notice to the employee of their obligation to make restitution. If, after a reasonable time, the employee has not paid the obligation in full or begun satisfactory repayment, the employer shall take steps to terminate the employee unless the employee is pursuing an administrative or judicial remedy.

Our agency has made several attempts to collect the referenced overpayment from your employee. We have been unable to collect the overpayment or to negotiate a standard payment agreement. In accordance with the above referenced General Statute, we are asking that you assist us in this collection effort by notifying the employee in writing of their obligation to make full restitution in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-553(b). Please direct the employee to call a Recovery Specialist at 919.707.1338.

If satisfactory arrangements have not been made by September 1, 2018, we will have no recourse but to ask that the employee be terminated in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §143-553(b).
