An attempt to file an attached claim for temporary layoff by {Employer's Name} was unsuccessful. Under North Carolina General Statute 96-15(a1) an employer may file an attached claim for an employee only once during a benefit year. Our records show that {Employer's Name} has filed a claim on your behalf within the previous twelve months.

To be eligible unemployment benefits you must file a claim based on your most recent separation. As a condition of your separation you will be required to conduct a work search (five contacts per week), maintain a record of your work search and certify weekly that you are meeting all weekly eligibility requirements.
